



WYOMING COURT NAVIGATOR PROJECT COURT USER AGREEMENT AND PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Wyoming Court Navigator Project offers help to people who need to use Wyoming's court system. The project is staffed with volunteers who are called **navigators**.

A navigator may help a person **who does not have a lawyer**, otherwise known as a self-represented litigant or SRL. A navigator may do some or all of the following:

- Provide overview information on court processes and procedures.
- Help an SRL find and complete approved forms.
- Identify resources and make referrals to both legal and nonlegal assistance.
- Help an SRL understand steps in the legal process.

A navigator is not a lawyer. A navigator **may not** provide legal advice or share personal opinions about an SRL's case. Information given to the navigator is not protected by attorney-client privilege and the navigator is not responsible for the outcome of a case.

The navigator is entitled to volunteer in a respectful environment. By seeking help from a navigator, an SRL agrees to display behavior that is free of discrimination, harassment, and disrespect.

Either the navigator or the SRL may end their consultation at any time, for any reason.

It is your responsibility to review any form completed with a Court Navigator to ensure you understand and approve the contents of the form. The Court Navigator takes no responsibility for the answers provided in the form.
